TUGUEGARAO CITY - The Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Statistical Services Office II (PSA-RSSO II) spearheaded the kick-off program of the 35th Civil Registration Month Celebration on 03 February 2025 with the theme: "Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future Fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS) System".

The CRM is celebrated every year pursuant to Proclamation No. 682 signed by former President Corazon C. Aquino which aims to remind us the importance of registering acts and events concerning status of a person and enhance nationwide awareness and appreciation of the legal, administrative and statistical values of civil registry documents.

The activity started with a motorcade within the primary routes of Tuguegarao City followed by a thanksgiving mass and a short program.
