An index of 135.0 in June 2025 means that consumer prices on the average have increased by 35.0 percent from 2018.

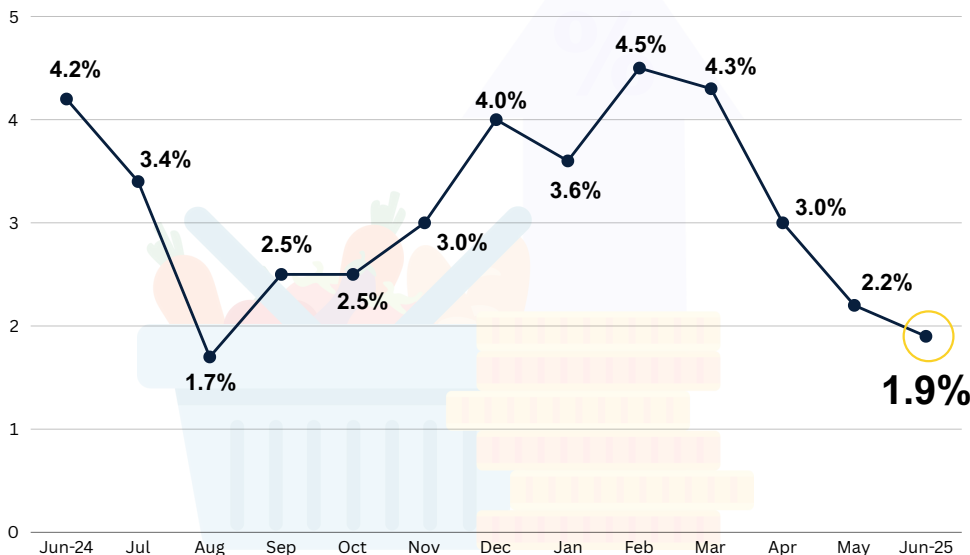

PURCHASING POWER OF PESO

In June 2025, the purchasing power of the peso is 74 centavos, or one peso in 2018 is worth 74 centavos in June 2025.

The inflation rate for bottom 30% income households in the province of Batanes decelerated further in June 2025 at 1.9 percent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage points from 2.2 percent in May 2025. Inflation in the province in June 2024 is relatively higher by 2.3 percentage points at 4.2 percent.
