## PSA – Isabela National ID Joins National Commission of Senior Citizen (NCSC) Distribution of Cash Gift for **Centenarian Senior Citizen**

26 February 2025 – ALICIA, ISABELA. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) -Isabela Provincial Statistical Office (IPSO) successfully conducted National ID registration at the Community Center, Alicia, Isabela, on February 26, 2025, in coordination with the National Commission of Senior Citizens (NCSC) for the distribution of cash incentives to beneficiaries aged 80, 85, 90, and 100 years old.

The octogenarians, nonagenarians, and centenarians who received the incentive were all registered in the National ID system, as required by the NCSC guidelines, where National ID registration serves as a primary requirement for the grants.

During the event, relatives and friends of senior citizens also availed themselves of the services provided by PSA, including the registration of individuals from birth onward, updating of demographic information, printing and issuance of National IDs in paper form, retrieval of lost Transaction Reference Numbers (TRNs), request for replacement of peeled-off National ID cards, assistance in accessing the Digital National ID, and tracking of National IDs.

Throughout the activity, PSA registered a total of 41 individuals, including 9 children aged 0 to 4 years old. Additionally, three (3) individuals updated or corrected their demographic information, and 19 National IDs in paper form were issued. The Digital National ID was also offered to those who had not yet downloaded their ePhilID.

The PSA - IPSO Isabela remains committed to providing essential services to priority groups in the community, aligning with the goal of establishing a seamless, secure, and universally accepted identification system for all Filipinos.
