Villaverde, Nueva Vizcaya | July 15, 2025 – The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) officially presented the 2024 Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Preliminary Results on Tuesday at the Sala de Conferencias, Casa del Pueblo, Ibung, Villaverde.

The activity was attended by department heads and staff from various LGU offices, representatives from the Philippine National Police, and visitors from the local business sector, and staff from PSA-Nueva Vizcaya. Among the key attendees was Engr. Joel P. Basco, Officer-in-Charge of the PSA Nueva Vizcaya Statistical Office.
