His comprehensive discussion covered the latest data on poverty incidence and other key socio-economic indicators affecting the Region II. Discussion on the importance and significance on the poverty data was delivered by Ms. Gina V. Dayag, Chief, Policy Formulation and Planning.

The open forum was marked by the active participation from attendees, with their questions addressed effectively by the speakers, allowing them to better understand the data, clarify statistical methodologies, and raise concerns related to poverty reduction efforts.
