The Municipality of Cordon, Isabela celebrated the successful issuance of Free Certificates of Live Birth to recipients under the PhilSys Birth Registration Assistance Project (PBRAP) in a heartwarming ceremony on January 15, 2024. The event, which was organized by the Philippine Statistics Authority-Isabela and the Local Government Unit of the Municipality of Cordon, was a critical turning point in the process of giving residents access to necessary identification cards.

A total of 104 beneficiaries received their Certificate of Live Birth in Security Paper (SECPA) during the ceremony. These certificates were given out as part of ongoing efforts to ensure that everyone is registered within the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) and contribute to a more efficient and inclusive national identification database.

Local officials, community leaders, and representatives from the Philippine Statistics Authority came together to witness the joyous occasion. During the ceremony, speakers highlighted the importance of having a valid Certificate of Live Birth, emphasizing its role in accessing various government services and opportunities.
