


AGRICULTURE



In 2022, there were a total of 587 holders of Emancipation Patents and closs in the region. While in 2028, the total number of holders slightly increased

Generally, for both years, there were more male holders than female in the region. However, in 2023, the number of male holders have slightly decreased to 345 from 366 in 2022, while the number of female holders increased from 221 to 280, resulting in a total of 625 holders.
